

MAGNT SKETCHING GUIDELINES

1. MAGNT welcomes sketching in its venues. All objects in the galleries may be sketched, for non-commercial purposes, providing guidelines are followed.
2. Only pencils may be used to sketch. The use of pens, oil paints, easels, or watercolours is not permitted.
3. Size of sketch pad may not exceed A3 size.
4. Sketching while sitting on the floor or on a portable stool is permitted. 5. Easels and other additional equipment (for example lights, ladders, and extension cords) are not permitted.
6. No portfolios, containers, or bags may be taken into the galleries.
7. A reasonable distance must be maintained from the work to allow a clear view for others who may wish to observe the work.
8. Visitors should never point at a work with a pencil or any other object. Works should not be touched for any reason.
9. Wall surfaces, showcases, or plinths should not be used to prop up work.
10. Due care must be taken to prevent the blocking of aisles and doorways. Visitors must cooperate with Visitor Engagement staff if asked to move. Should a VEO determine the galleries are too busy, sketching will not be permitted.
11. Staff members may ask Visitors to move for the safety of the objects on display or other Visitors.
12. Groups and classes must make appointments for sketching in advance through the Engagement Manager or MCA Manager.

EXCEPTIONS:

1. Exhibitions and displays that include works on loan from other institutions or lenders may be subject to different conditions imposed by the lender. If lender restrictions apply they will be signed at the entry to the exhibition.
2. These guidelines do not apply to MAGNT organised public and education programs and other activities supervised by a MAGNT staff member.
