2025 Telstra National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art Awards Finalists Announced

71 finalist works have been announced for this year's 2025 *Telstra National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art Awards Telstra (NATSIAA),* Australia's longest running and most prestigious art awards of its kind, presented by the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory (MAGNT) and Principal Partner Telstra on Larrakia Country (Darwin).

Now in its 42nd year, the 2025 *Telstra NATSIAA* features Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists from across Australia, sharing incredible works reflecting the continuation of cultures, responses to current affairs and unerring connections to Country.

Telstra NATSIAA recognises the quality and diversity of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander art throughout Australia and continues to grow appreciation and understanding of First Peoples arts and cultural practice. *Telstra NATSIAA* has been a career-changer for many of the finalists and award winners since its inception.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people have shaped the Awards through their contributions as artists, curators, coordinators, selection panellists and judges.

Selected from 216 entries, all finalist works will be exhibited at MAGNT, Darwin, from 21 June 2025 until 26 January 2026 and are eligible to win one of the following award categories:

- Telstra Art Award \$100,000
- Telstra General Painting Award \$15,000
- Telstra Bark Painting Award \$15,000
- Telstra Work on Paper Award \$15,000
- Wandjuk Marika 3D Memorial Award (sponsored by Telstra) \$15,000
- Telstra Emerging Artist Award \$15,000
- Telstra Multimedia Award \$15,000

The Telstra People's Choice Award, is a non-monetary award, chosen by popular vote. Members of the public can vote for their favourite work via a QR code for the duration of the exhibition.

Fast facts

There were 216 entries with 71 finalists chosen.

38 finalists are from the Northern Territory, 8 from South Australia, 5 from Queensland, 10 from Western Australia, 3 from New South Wales, 1 from the ACT and 6 artists from Victoria were selected. There are no finalists from Tasmania this year. 14 finalists fall under the Emerging Artist category.

Telstra NATSIAA is the longest running Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander art award in Australia and is a celebration of culture, artistic practice and connection to Country, presented by MAGNT and Principal Partner, Telstra on Larrakia Country.
